Membership Eligibility includes:

- Marines with honorable active or reserve service in the U.S. Marine Corps for no less than 90 days active service.
- FMF U.S. Navy Corpsman who have earned the Marine Corps Device and served no less than 90 days with an active Marine FMF Unit.
- U.S. Navy Chaplains who have earned the FMF Badge and served no less than 90 days with an active Marine FMF Unit.

The Espírit de Corps among the membership is embodied by our motto... "Semper Fidelis" - "Always Faithful."

PRIVATE FIRST CLASS Engene Arnold Obregon 11/12/1930 - 9/26/1950 United States Marine Corps

Posthumously Awarded the Medal of Honor | Korean War

Pfc. Obregon was awarded the Medal of Honor Posthumously for conspicuous gallantry & intrepidity at the risk of his life above and beyond the call of duty while serving with Company G, in action against enemy aggressor forces. While pinned down by hostile fire, Pfc. Obregon rushed to the aid of a fellow wounded Marine- dragging him to a safer area, bandaging his wounds and ultimately using his body as a shield until he himself was fatally wounded by enemy gunfire. Pfc. Obregon's heroic actions enabled his fellow Marines to rescue the wounded man and repel against the attack thereby sustaining and enhancing the highest traditions of the U.S. Naval Service. He gallantly gave his life for his country.
